SCHOOL PARTNERED SHAKESPEARE RESIDENCY PROGRAM

As part of an elective or after-school residency, the St. Louis Shakespeare Festival Education Team of teaching artists curate a multi-week Shakespeare training experience that is unique to a partner's school's needs, values and communities. The team then administers, teaches and directs an abridged Shakespeare play, starring the students of the partnering school celebrating their dramatic discoveries! This in-depth and hands-on study of the Bard's work develops literacy skills and comfortability with complex texts, while the production process provides a pivotal and fun experience in personal accountability and collaboration!

When Does the Residency Take Place?

Semester-Long Residencies last 10-16 weeks.
50-90 minute sessions are recommended at
least twice a week

Works as Elective or After-School Program

Where Does It Take Place?

Instruction and Performances take place on
the school partner's campus. Teaching Artists
work with school admin to facilitate the use of
available space

How Many Students? What Grade levels?

Minimum 6 students- Maximum 30 students.
Curriculums are tailored to grades 4-12th
